Victoria Driver Profile Checklist

What photos you need to upload:

- Your gorgeous face**
Why? Passengers need to be able to identify you during pick up
- Your car: front, back and side view**
Why? We need to check your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition. Please upload a photo of the front of your car first.
- The front of your drivers licence**
Why? We need to check you are the insured driver, and that you are who you say you are!
- The back of your drivers licence (with current home address if changed)**
Why? This is also for verification purposes.
- Your car registration**
Why? So that we can verify that your car is registered to be on the road.
- A Commercial Passenger Vehicle Licence (known as a hire car licence)**
Why? So that your vehicle is registered to drive passengers for commercial gain.
How? Head to the TSC website to begin [your application](#).
- A roadworthy certificate that is less than 12 months old**
Why? This tells us whether your car is safe enough to be picking up the most precious cargo – our passengers! We don't have an age limit for cars, so this ensures your vehicle will safely get passengers from A to B.
How? Head to [licensed vehicle tester](#) anywhere in Victoria.
- Current rideshare insurance for the car you'll be driving**
Why? Not all car insurance covers rideshare drivers. As there are different liabilities involved with driving passengers, make sure your broker explains the impact of ridesharing on your policy.
How? You can get a quote for rideshare insurance [here](#).
- A valid passenger driver accreditation**
Why? A driver accreditation is required for drivers of public passenger vehicles.
How? To get this, take a completed [driver accreditation form](#) and [health questionnaire](#) to your GP and then return it to the [Taxi Services Commission](#). Please remember that you need to take *both* of these forms to your doctor's appointment. In step 4 of the form, tick 'hire car' driver.
- A Working With Children Check valid for paid work**
Why? The WWCC assures us and our passengers that we can trust you to transport children and keep them out of harm while you drive.
