Western Australia Driver Profile Checklist

What photos you need to upload:

- Your gorgeous face**
Why? Passengers need to be able to identify you during pick up.
- Your car: front, back and side view**
Why? We need to check your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition. Please upload a photo of the front of your car first.
- The front of your drivers licence with F or T licence extension**
Why? We need to check you are the insured driver, and that you are allowed to drive a vehicle carrying passengers for hire!
How? Head to the [Department of Transport website](#) to get started on your application, including police check and medical check.
- The back of your drivers licence** (with current home address if changed)
Why? This is also for verification purposes.
- Your vehicle licence**
Why? So that we can verify that your car is registered to be on the road.
- A vehicle examination that is less than 12 months old**
Why? This tells us whether your car is safe enough to be picking up the most precious cargo – our passengers! We don't have an age limit for cars, so this ensures your vehicle will safely get passengers from A to B.
How? Head to a [vehicle examination centre](#) anywhere in Western Australia.
- Current rideshare insurance for the car you'll be driving**
Why? Not all car insurance covers rideshare drivers. WA law requires hire car (rideshare) drivers to have class 3(f) motor injury insurance, which costs \$571.65 according to the [Department of Transport website](#).
How? You can get a quote for rideshare insurance [here](#).
- A valid Omnibus Charter Vehicle Licence**
Why? A charter vehicle licence from the Department of Transport is required to use your vehicle for rideshare purposes.
How? To get this, fill out the [application](#) from the Department of Transport website and deliver it to one of the addresses at the bottom of the form.
- A Working With Children Check valid for paid work**
Why? The WWCC assures us and our passengers that we can trust you to transport children and keep them out of harm while you drive.
