

Tasmania Driver Profile Checklist

What photos you need to upload:

Your car: front, back and side view Why? We need to check your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition. Please upload a photo of the front of your car first.
The front of your drivers licence Why? We need to verify that you are who you say you are, and that your licence is current.
The back of your drivers licence (with current home address if changed) Why? This is also for verification purposes, and we'll be looking for the 'X' condition attachment, which verifies that your car is registered for ride-sourcing in Tasmania. How? Fill out form MR49 and send it to ridesource@stategrowth.tas.gov.au.
Your vehicle registration Why? So that we can verify that your car is registered to be on the road. You must be the registered driver of the vehicle you are using for Shebah.
A vehicle inspection that is less than 12 months old Why? As we don't have an age limit for vehicles, this tells us whether your car is fit to be picking up the most precious cargo – our passengers! How? Book an inspection online here .
Current rideshare insurance for the car you'll be driving Why? Not all car insurance covers rideshare drivers. As part of the application process you are required to notify your insurance provider that you will be using your vehicle for rideshare and ensure that you and your passengers will be adequately covered in the event of accident or injury. How? You can get a quote for rideshare insurance here .
Proof that you have a valid Ancillary Certificate Why? This certificate allows you be a ride-source (rideshare) driver in the state of Tasmania. How? Fill out form MR48 – Application for Ancillary Certificate, including your Working with Children Registration information and a medical declaration. You'll also need a National Police Certificate from Tasmania Police, a type 2 AIS vehicle inspection report that is less than 30 days old and a passport quality photo to complete your application. Send all of these documents to ridesource@stategrowth.tas.gov.au.
A Working with Children Registration card Why? The registration to work with children assures us and our passengers that we can trust you to transport children and keep them out of harm while you drive.

* Already a ride-source driver for another company? No problem!

How? Apply online on the Tasmanian Department of Justice website.

If you already hold an Ancillary Certificate, let the Tasmanian Department of State Growth know that you will be driving for Shebah by filling out **sections 1, 2, 4 and 6** of <u>form MR48</u> and emailing it to ridesource@stategrowth.tas.gov.au.
