



## NT Driver Profile Checklist

### You'll need to upload photos of:

- Your face** so passengers can identify you upon pickup.
- Your car** so we can confirm your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition.
- The front and back of your Driver's License** so we can check you are the insured driver.

### Documents you'll need to acquire and upload a photo of:

- H Endorsement and a Commercial Passenger Vehicle Identity Card** - Can take up to ten working days, and costs \$27 in total!
  - Before you begin the [application](#), you need:
    - Your current Open NT drivers licence
    - To pass a [Hire and Reward knowledge test](#) (you can do a *free* practice test [here](#))
    - A current [National Police Certificate](#) issued by SAFE NT that is not older than three months
    - A [medical assessment](#) completed and signed by a medical practitioner. It can't be older than six months
    - Your ABN
- Commercial Vehicle Licence** - It costs \$300.
  - Firstly, your vehicle must meet the vehicle maintenance requirements, which include:
    - Being nine years old or under
    - Pass a roadworthy inspection no longer than six weeks before you applied for the licence
      - Find an authorised inspection station [here](#)
        - And make sure you look out for the stations that have 'E' listed under vehicle category
  - Second, you will need to fill in the [online application](#).
  - Once you're vehicle is approved, you will need to pay the licence fee and insurance.

- As an additional motor accident compensation insurance is part of the vehicle registration.
  
- Car Registration** - This takes under a minute!
  - Just go [here](#) and enter in your rego plate number. Then click “search.”
  - Simply take a photo or screenshot the results!
  
- Insurance** - This is a quick one too.
  - Just tell your insurer you’ll be driving for rideshare, and talk to them about the best option. They’re the experts in this case.
  - If you want another expert opinion, head [here](#).
  
- Roadworthy Certificate** - Easy, as this has already been completed for your CVL!
  - Find an approved inspection station near you [here](#).
  
- Working with Children Check/Ochre Card** - Cost \$70, and this application must be done in one sitting.
  - Make sure you have the following documents with you before you commence:
    - A debit or credit card
    - An email address
    - An Australian residential and postal address
    - Scanned copies of your [identity documents](#) to meet 100 points of identification, and a [passport sized photo](#) to be used on the Ochre card
  - Fill out the online application [here](#).
  - If you would prefer to do the application in person, print out the hard copy version [here](#) and lodge it either in person at SAFE Northern Territory office or at a Territory Business Centre.
