



TAS Driver Profile Checklist

You'll need to upload photos of:

- Your face** so passengers can identify you upon pickup.
- Your car** so we can confirm your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition.
- The front and back of your Driver's License** so we can check you are the insured driver.

Documents you'll need to acquire and upload a photo of:

- Ancillary Certificate** - Get this done first! It costs \$122.45.
 - Firstly, you will need to obtain a [National Police Certificate from Tasmania Police](#). This costs \$45.00.
 - You will also need to provide a vehicle inspection report. Find an approved inspection station near you [here](#).
 - Fill out [this form](#), and once completed send it to ridesource@stategrowth.tas.gov.au
- Car Registration** - This takes under a minute, and it's free!
 - Just go [here](#) and enter in your rego plate number. Then click "search."
 - Simply take a photo or screenshot the results!
- Insurance** - This is a quick one too.
 - Just tell your insurer you'll be driving for rideshare, and talk to them about the best option. They're the experts in this case.
 - If you want another expert opinion, head [here](#).
- Roadworthy Certificate** - If your car is under 12 months old, you don't need one!
 - Find an approved inspection station near you [here](#).
 - If your car is less than 12 months old, just upload your Car Registration here.
- Working with Children Registration** - It costs \$110.60, and generally it can take a couple of days for the application to be approved.

- ❑ Apply [here](#). Make sure you register it as an employment application.
- ❑ Either print the application receipt or write down your reference number, as you'll be needing that for later!
- ❑ Pay the application fee.
- ❑ Then make a visit to [Service Tasmania](#), where you will have to provide proof of identity and have your photo taken!
