New South Wales Driver Profile Checklist

What photos you need to upload:

- Your gorgeous face**
Why? Passengers need to be able to identify you during pick up
- Your car: front, back and side view**
Why? We need to check your car is the one registered and insured, and that it is in good condition. Please upload a photo of the front of your car first.
- The front of your drivers licence**
Why? We need to check you are the insured driver, and that you are who you say you are!
- The back of your drivers licence** (with current home address if changed)
Why? This is also for verification purposes.
- Your car registration**
Why? So that we can verify that your car is registered to be on the road.
- A safety check that is less than 12 months old**
Why? This tells us whether your car is safe enough to be picking up the most precious cargo – our passengers! We don't have an age limit for cars, so this ensures your vehicle will safely get passengers from A to B.
How? Head to [an authorised inspection station](#) anywhere in New South Wales.
- Current rideshare insurance for the car you'll be driving**
Why? Not all car insurance covers rideshare drivers. NSW law requires all rideshare drivers to have third party property damage cover of at least \$5,000,000. As there are different liabilities involved with driving passengers, make sure your broker explains the impact of ridesharing on your policy.
How? You can get a quote for rideshare insurance [here](#).
- A valid Passenger Transport License Code**
Why? A Passenger Transport License Code from Point-to-Point Transport is required for drivers of public passenger vehicles.
How? To get this, fill out the [application](#) and declare a medical condition via the form. Then submit the form along with necessary identification at a Service NSW centre. You can read more about the process [here](#).
- A Working With Children Check valid for paid work**
Why? The WWCC assures us and our passengers that we can trust you to transport children and keep them out of harm while you drive.
